Juggle Time




I Got the Power!

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Eagle Scout

Did you know *you* can help bald eagles? One of the biggest dangers to bald eagles today is...humans! When we leave trash and plastic wrappers on the ground, they might eat that litter and choke. Eagles can also get tangled up in fishing lines or strings from balloons that float away. So when you see litter, clean it up! You might just save an eagle's life! Can you find some trash to clean up right now?

Eagle Eye

Eagles like Earnest have great evesight! They can see a rabbit two miles away! Can you have eagle eyes? Try to find something...

- smaller than your pinky fingernail.
- made out of wood.
- alive that's not a human.
- sharp.
- in the sky.

- that makes you smile.
- you can eat.
- that wasn't in the same place yesterday.
- that makes you feel hopeful.

Catch the Wind

Isaiah 40:31 brings us hope! It says, "But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint."

Eagles soar on "thermal currents"—waves of air that carry different temperatures. They don't even need to flap their wings very much! Can you catch the air? Try this.

- 1. Put a finger in the air and see if you can feel a breeze. (Even if you're inside, there might be a current from the air conditioning!)
- 2. See if you can tell which direction the wind is blowing.
- 3. Still can't tell? Get something really light, like a tissue, and dangle it to see if the wind blows it.
- 4. Stretch out your "wings" and glide on the current, imagining the wind—and the hope Jesus brings—is carrying you.
