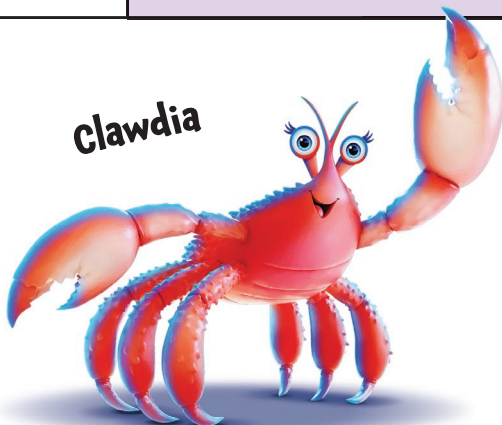

Eagles soar on "thermal currents"—waves of air that carry different temperatures. They don't even need to flap their wings very much! Can you catch the air? Try this.

1. Put a finger in the air and see if you can feel a breeze. (Even if you're inside, there might be a current from the air conditioning!)
2. See if you can tell which direction the wind is blowing.
3. Still can't tell? Get something really light, like a tissue, and dangle it to see if the wind blows it.
4. Stretch out your "wings" and glide on the current, imagining the wind—and the hope Jesus brings—is carrying you.

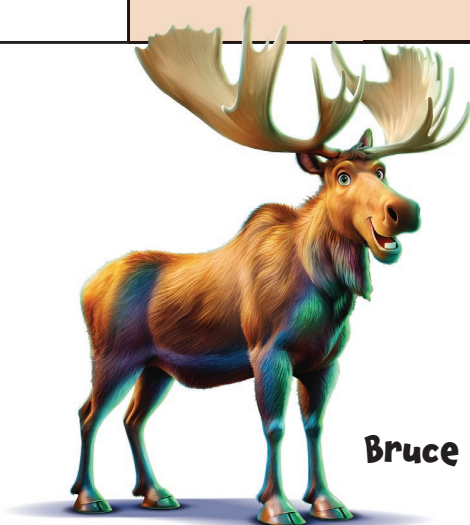
